2.	Principal's address and report	Jason H	10 min

Struggling with staffing as are all ACT schools, online meetings are the norm amongst staff. Working closely with Directorate to manage & monitor staffing. Overall focus on continuity of learning. Increase on staff absences. Last term there was a triage plan put in place and older students - mass supervision & online learning. Younger classes, physical supervision in place. Staff have been exceptional and supportive, taking on the extra challenge, ensuring students stay the focus. Recognises for our teachers that is not a long term solution.

There has been an impact on things around the school – ability to maintain school improvement efforts have reduced while the triaging of supervision of children.

Reminder of pupil free day on Friday 5 August 2022, please contact the school if supervision is required.

Parent complaints and concerns – spoke about a form recently provided parents can access and provide concerns or feedback. More than one person will receive the message and the leadership team will decide who is best to respond to the concern, but would appreciate and encourage positive feedback as well! QR code works but don't copy and paste the link as it is case sensitive.

Excited that in term 4 we will have a school review. It will look at our progress towards our strategic improvement plan, feedback on what has been achieved, what should be improved further and this will be shared. External feedback is very beneficial.

Warm welcome to Patrice, new Director of Primary.

Question – what is available in regard to substitute teachers?

There are a few steady relief teachers, but they are few and far between. There has been a question received from the community about whether they can help. Clarification from the Directorate has been sought, as to whether other community members who are not employed teachers can support in a relief capacity.

*Question – Who is on the enrolment acceptance panel?*Miriam, Patrice, Florence, Anna, Kylie and Jason.

Comment - There used to be a parent member on that panel to ensure decisions were transparent and justifiable.

Question – last year there was a human rights complaint lodged, the Directorate and the school refused to engage in a conciliatory process. In December 2021 was told there would be a new approach and policy, but as at August 2022 there has not been any progress. Recommend bringing the Human Rights Commission in for conversation. Working with governance and legal team at Edu Directorate for advice. Can't progress without being in alignment with the Directorate and is trying to get a timeline.

Comment – suggest parent community feedback form might receive more variety of feedback, rather than a complaints form.

- What is the School's response to bullying issues?
 - Comments from community, recent issues dealt with well. Ensure parent voice will be heard and in review for processes.
 - What will be put in place for expert support in terms of learning or social difficulties? Is it the role of the parent or the teachers to call out?
 - Teachers are welcoming of support, there are students who have behaviour support and LSA, there is also an allied support team who is accessed as appropriate. Teachers are willing to participate. Parents can call out concerns and ask for help, contact the school.
- When can parents expect the release of school board minutes.
 - Looking to share board agenda with population, then a summary of the conversation. The advice from Governance is the specific minutes should not be shared because of the nature of board conversations, board members and invited guests, which can contain sensitive information.
 - Goal is to have agenda out close to meeting and a report within around a week. Board Chair wants to ensure it is transparent and effective communications, eg not sending minutes for the sake of it, with no content.
- Booking Sports Hall
 - o Is the Sport Hall used at full capacity?
 - o How is the booking managed?
 - o How do we get more visibility of capacity availability for the Hall
 - Best way is to get in touch with Business Manager. People wanting to hire school facilities will need to have PL insurance, there are a couple of limitations, but if we can open the school to different community groups, become more of a community hub, that would be great.
- Request that the school upgrade the meeting room infrastructure to support hybrid face/video meetings in the interest of supporting both health and flexibility needs of staff, parents and students. Consideration of P&C support advocacy and/or funding if necessary.
 - There are facilities available and are used for staff meetings etc. There is an ITO. P&C will talk to the ITO to see what is possible for future large meetings.
