## Telopea Park School – Satisfaction Survey results 2017-2022 analysis

The attached School Satisfaction Survey results are drawn from data provided by the Education Directorate under a recent FOI application. The annual survey asks parents, students and staff how much they agree with various statements about school performance and culture. The results on the following pages provide the raw TPS results, as well as the percentage difference of results from the other K-10 ACT schools.

## Notable

- Out of 25 questions, Telopea parents were more satisfied than the ACT average in only 3
  areas: my child feels safe, likes being at this school and is happy at this school. All other areas
  were below the ACT average and in most areas were significantly below the ACT average. This
  indicates that children are happy at this school, despite the school's performance, not because
  of it.
- There is a high rate of parents reporting they do not believe student behaviour is well managed, but also high rates of reporting that their children feel safe at Telopea. The school should conduct additional investigations to understand what parents' concerns are.
- 2022 results show significant falls in parental satisfaction with
  - Teachers expecting each child to do their best, motivating children to learn, treating children fairly and giving useful feedback.
  - The school looking for ways to improve and taking parents opinions seriously.

### **Notable**

Staff report significantly lower satisfaction than the ACT average with: feedback on their performance; that staff are well supported by the school; or that the school takes their opinions seriously.

### **Overall analysis**

#### 1. Unfair teacher behaviour

Staff, parents and students all report concerns that teachers at Telopea do not treat students fairly. The fact that all three stakeholders report this consistently since 2017 (where some parents and students age out of the school and new parents and students enter the school) indicates this is an ongoing problem of some individual teachers. This is an area of great concern and should be investigated to gain a better understanding of what are the specific concerns, such as via exit interviews, which are a valuable way of understanding why some parents are choosing to remove their children from Telopea, or (as per anecdotal evidence) are selecting between different language streams. As part of this, it would be valuable to conduct separate satisfaction surveys for the English and French streams to understand if this is a global or targeted problem.

## 2. Feedback on learning and teaching

Students and parents are not satisfied with how teachers motivate students or explain the work. However, teachers also report strong dissatisfaction with feedback they receive on their performance. This indicates that although parents raise concerns with the school, these concerns are not actioned by providing pedagogical feedback and support to teachers.

These concerns are upheld when you view Telopea Park School naplan performances on MySchool, which show that Telopea performs consistently lower than similar ISCEA schools. In other words, the lack of feedback to students and teachers is having a measurably negative effect on the educational outcomes of students at Telopea.

This would indicate that executive teachers should focus more on improving the professional support given to teachers to improve their pedagogy and potentially to share practice tips. This issue is further highlighted by staff also reporting very low satisfaction (37%) with the communication between staff.

#### 3. The school does not listen or value the opinions of stakeholders.

Staff, parents and students all report they believe the school does not value their opinion, and they also all report that they believe the school does not value community partnerships. This issue compounds the effects of concerns around learning and teaching feedback. It indicates that when students, parents and teachers discuss their performance concerns with the school executive, those concerns are dismissed and not addressed.

This indicates that school executives need to do better in listening, valuing and taking action on the opinions of all stakeholders in the Telopea Park School community.
